APV - ReThinkers

Purpose

This briefing provides a short introduction to the survey conducted among the ReThinkers with the purpose of investigating the physical and psychosocial working environment (APV).

Background

The data was collected from 6 October 2017 to 24 October 2017. The Aarhus 2017 Foundation collected the data. The APV was exclusively a quantitative survey. A questionnaire was distributed to 484 ReThinkers corresponding to a sample of approx. 10%. Respondents were randomly selected. The response rate was 58.3% - of which 3.3% were partly completed.


Main results

The results are presented in three sections: overall satisfaction, physical working environment and psychosocial working environment.

Overall satisfaction

73% responded that they to a great extent or to a large extent were overall satisfied with the working environment.

Figure 1: Overall satisfaction - both physical and the Psychosocial working environment






Physical working environment

72% find that they are to a great or to a large extent satisfied with the physical working environment.

Figure 2: Physical working environment




Most of the volunteers are satisfied with their physical working environment:

- 94 % find there are sufficient time to carry out tasks in a proper manner with regards to safety
- 76 % find to a great or large extent that it is clear what your tasks comprise
- 75 % find to a great or large extent that it is clear who is responsible for induction training for new tasks

Psychosocial working environment

95% are to a great extent or to a large extent satisfied with the psychological surroundings in general.

Most of the volunteers are satisfied with their psychosocial working environment:

- 97 % find to a great or large extent that there is a good atmosphere between them and the other Re-Thinkers
- 94 % find to a great or large extent they have sufficient time to carry out your tasks in a satisfactory manner
- 93 % find to a great or large extent that they are proud to be a volunteer with European Capital of Culture Aarhus 2017
